JASON KELLER/ CJM RACING TEAM FAST FACTS:

- The America's Incredible Pizza Company race team finished 18th last week at Daytona International Speedway. The solid finish enabled Keller to maintain his top-10 position in the driver point standings
- Chicagoland is hosting their first ever NASCAR Nationwide Series night race at the mile-and-a-half facility
- Keller has six starts at Chicagoland Speedway with an average starting position of 25th and finishing position of 13th
- Keller has logged the most laps (out of any active driver) at Chicagoland Speedway with 1191 completed out of 1200 in six races (99.2%)
- Keller has accumulated two top-five and four top-10 finishes at the Chicagoland
- In 441 career starts; Keller has 10 wins, 81 top-five and 165 top-10 finishes. He currently holds the all-time career start record and winning's in the NASCAR Nationwide Series
- The America's Incredible Pizza Company race team will be running chassis #03 at Chicagoland; #03 has run at Las Vegas (18th) and Kentucky (10th)
- The Dollar General 300 will be broadcast live on ESPN this Friday, July 11th at 7:30 PM (EST)
